## Level 1

**Supplies:** Food and other ordinary goods needed by people every day.

**Native:** A person who was born in a particular place.

**To domesticate:** To bring animals under human control in order to provide food, power, or company.

## Level 3

**To disobey:** To refuse to do something that you are told to do.

**To seize:** To take something quickly and keep or hold it.

**To beach:** To pull or force a boat, etc. out of the water onto the land.

**Salvation:** (A way of) being saved from danger, loss, or harm.

**To tame:** To make a wild animal tame (not wild or dangerous, either naturally or because of training or long involvement with humans).

**Bower:** A pleasant place under the branches of a tree in a wood or garden.

**To yearn:** To desire something strongly, especially something difficult or impossible to obtain.

**Mutiny:** An occasion when a group of people, especially soldiers or sailors, refuses to obey orders and/or attempts to take control from people in authority.
